BIRMINGHAM – SHUTTLESWORTH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

The Birmingham Airport Authority (BAA) is issuing a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for a Program Manager (PM) for the Terminal Modernization Program (TMP) at the Birmingham–Shuttlesworth International Airport. Instructions for obtaining an RFQ package are noted below.

It is anticipated that possibly as early as, November, 2009, the BAA will require the services of a PM for both pre-construction and construction services. The selected PM will contract directly with the BAA.

The BAA has embarked on a TMP to accommodate future growth, update the aging terminal facility and accommodate new security requirements. The program was initiated in the BAA Airport Master Plan process and envisions a new Concourse A, the replacement of Concourse B, renovated Concourse C, expanded and renovated terminal facilities, and potential new covered connections from the terminal to the parking deck.

The BAA is seeking a highly qualified professional firm, or team of firms to provide Program Management services in connection with the proposed TMP at the Birmingham–Shuttlesworth International Airport, Birmingham, Alabama.

The project scope of services shall include all the work associated with providing those consulting services requisite to the development, monitoring, implementation of cost controls, and those controls associated with the efforts required to bring about the successful completion of the project on time and within budget. Furthermore, the scope shall not be limited to the stated items included in this document, but shall govern all accomplishments to assist in providing budgeting, cost models, project schedule, budget tracking, coordination and assisting in meetings, invoice review and execution, report assembly, update, plan review, monitoring, and generally assisting the Owner in the administering of the project.

DBE Policy: It is the policy of the BAA that DBEs as defined in 49 CFR Part 26 will have maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of all Authority projects and the Proposer will take all necessary and reasonable steps to ensure that DBEs have the maximum opportunity to compete for and perform subcontracts.

The RFQ will include a scope of services for the pre-construction and construction phases, the proposal format with submission guidelines and selection information along with other information helpful in preparing the submission. Qualified submittals in response to the RFQ will be reviewed by the BAA and a shortlist of the best responses will be notified of their invitation to an interview with the BAA for purposes of the final selection of a PM for the Project.
