PROJECT / EQUIPMENT

To re-paint existing airfield striping and markings on the runways, taxiways of the Birmingham-Shuttlesworth International Airport, including taxiway centerlines, taxiway edge lines, taxiway/runway/ILS hold markings, movement area boundary markings, runway centerlines, runway edge lines, precision markings, touchdown zone markings, threshold markings, numbers, all other runway markings, and blast pad markings .

PROJECT / EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS

All striping and markings must be done in accordance with the FAA issued AC 150/5340-1J.

Outlining of the striping or markings with a black border and enhancements of the taxiway centerlines will be required in accordance with AC 150/5340-1J.

Type 3 glass beads will be required on all runway, taxiway and ILS holding position markings.

Type 1 glass beads will be used on all other markings and striping as required in AC150/5340-1J.

Glass beads must meet the specifications found in AC 150/5370-10E

Approximate paint quantities are as follows

White 247,710 square feet

Yellow 115,382 square feet

Red 1,900 square feet

Black quantity based on specifications for black borders found in AC 150/5370-1J

Paint must meet the specifications found in AC 150/5370-10E

Paint and application rates must meet the specification found in AC 150/5370-10E

Marking and striping diagram can be provided as a reference only and is not intended to define the scope of work to be performed.

Remove 1 existing set of runway blast pad markings via water blasting and replace.
