1. **Question:** Please provide the quantity, model number(s), and feature/function software version(s) of the Authority's existing handheld radios to be retained/reprogrammed for use on the new UHF simulcast radio system.

Answer: **Number of Radios:** Approximately 50

Radio Model: Motorola XPR 7550e

Software version: Firmware – R02.10.00.0001

CP Version – 15.00.16

Last Updated: 10-10-2023

The radios are to be retained and reprogrammed for use with the new UHF system.

2. **Question:** Does BHM currently have a digital paging system? If so, what is the make and model?

Answer: We do not have a fully digital PA system, and it will be upgraded and replaced this coming fiscal year

3. **Question:** What is the current radio system in use at BHM?

Answer: MIP 5000

4. **Question:** What is the current phone system in use at BHM?

Answer: Mitel

5. **Question:** Within the section “Expectation of Work”, there is mention of “the Capacity Plus MotoTrbo system”. Should this be interpreted as BHM already has this Capacity Plus system, or this is what is being specified to be provided as part of this project deployment?

Answer: To be provided

6. **Question:** The RFP mentions APX radios. Is there a specified model of radio BAA is looking to procure for this deployment?

Answer: Would like to stay with Motorola, no model specified. One that is capable of pairing with the new dispatch console with associated features that can take advantage of the systems’ capabilities.

7. **Question:** It is stated that the term of this project agreement will be 6 months, however there is no mention of a tentative project timeline. Is there an anticipated start and end date that BAA has in mind for this project?

Answer: The vendor should specify the timeline to supply equipment and installation in their proposal. The BAA does not have a set timeline.
