

- Birmingham-Shuttlesworth International Airport is the most active airport in the state of Alabama.

Goal & Scope of Project

The goal of this procurement effort is to enter a contract with the best-valued Contractor to Install new pedestrian crosswalk safety lighting

Scope of Project:

Install new pedestrian crosswalk safety lighting at the terminal curb front drive for both the arrivals passenger and commercial curb front and departures curb front. The project includes demolition and new construction in both concrete paving and asphalt paving locations, and new striping at each location.

Project Proposal Selection Process & Criteria

- Proposals will be evaluated based on the proposer's ability to meet the performance requirements of this RFP
- The evaluation and selection will be based on the following:
 - i. Contractor's capability to perform all aspects of the scope of work
 - ii. Contractor's proposed approach to the services at BHM
 - iii. Contractor's recent experience in performing similar services
 - iv. Contractor's commitment to the MBE/WBE Participation Goal
 - v. Contractor's proposed cost

Title VI Assurance
