ADDITIONAL INFORMATION/CLARIFICATIONS/DESCRIBED BELOW:

- 1. Question:** Are all insurance stipulations recommended or mandatory?
Answer: We can negotiate insurance requirements.
- 2. Question:** Will we have access to water from BAA or do we have to bring our own water?
Answer: We only have one access to water, it's on the bottom level outside near walk around by the terminal building.
- 3. Question:** When was the last time the awnings were cleaned?
Answer: We don't know the specific date on when it was cleaned.
- 4. Question:** Are you just needing the underside cleaned or the top as well?
Answer: Both need to be cleaned.
- 5. Question:** Can you provide the sqFt for the total sidewalk area, number of awnings and sqFt?
Answer: Refer to the diagram provided for sqft in the RFQ.
- 6. Question:** Does the scope of work include all sides of awning (top, sides and bottom), all poles that hold the awning in place and all support wiring that connect to the awning?
Answer: Yes
- 7. Question:** What type of lift is provided by the BAA?
Answer: We have two types of lifts, one is a 30ft articulating lift and a 30ft scissor lift.
- 8. Question:** What is considered after hours for BAA? After 4pm? After 5pm? Before 8am?
Answer: After 8pm to be scheduled through BAA once awarded.

9. Question: If workman comp insurance is not required for our company to carry. Is it required for this job?

Answer: Contractor will need to send the COI for review along with their Bid. We will discuss further with the winning Bidder. The BAA is open for discussion with the winning Bidder.
