Each Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond, submitted in the form of a guaranty and/or promissory note from a banking, insurance, or other lending or financial institutions, equal to five (5%) per cent of the bid price and made payable to the Birmingham Airport Authority. No cash, checks, or money orders will be accepted.
