The Birmingham Airport Authority (the “Authority”) is seeking a highly qualified firm or team of firms (each, a “Respondent”), to provide Professional Consulting Services capable of providing hazardous materials testing and abatement monitoring services in conjunction with the Federally Funded Noise Abatement Programs at the Birmingham–Shuttlesworth International Airport.

The Authority is interested in the procurement of services to facilitate the abatement of hazardous materials for two (2) former church building facilities, and several vacant residential dwellings purchased by the Authority. Respondents should be highly experienced and proficient in the full range of hazardous materials (specifically asbestos) and lead base paint surveying to confirm the presence, type, and quantities thereof by careful examination of each structure utilizing approved techniques in accordance to local, state, and federal standards inclusive of NESHAP.

A Pre-Submittal Conference will be held on Thursday, March 8, 2018, starting at 2:00 p.m. local time at the Birmingham-Shuttlesworth International Airport’s Meeting Room A, located at 5900 Messer-Airport Highway, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.

Meeting Room A is situated adjacent to the Birmingham Police Substation in the Airport Terminal Building’s lower level. All interested participants are strongly urged to attend this conference.
