GENERAL:

This Addendum will form a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original Request for Quotes (RFQ) Documents dated March 2019. The following Conditions, Drawings, Specification changes, etc. take precedence over items in the Drawings and Specifications of the RFQ Documents. Portions of the RFQ Documents not changed by this Addendum remain in effect. Recipients of this Addendum are advised to provide this Addendum to anyone to whom they further distribute without the BAA's knowledge.

Participants in this RFQ are required to acknowledge receipt of this Addendum along with their quote.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION / CLARIFICATIONS / ATTACHMENTS DESCRIBED BELOW:

1. The following questions have been asked:

Question – Does the base bid itself include any installation, or is all the installation part of the optional items?

Answer – No cabinet installation will be required for this request.

Question – The RFQ asks for each AED to have two spare batteries and two spare adult pads. The AED does come with one of each, would you like each AED to have the battery and adult pads it comes with and two additional spares (each AED would then have three batteries and three adult pad sets)?

Answer - The RFQ is requesting for two spare batteries and pads; for a total of three sets for each AED unit.

Question – Does the RFQ request 45 or 56 AEDs? Is Alternate 1 something we must bid on?

Answer – The base bid is for 45 AED units and Alternate 1 includes an additional 56 units. Alternative 1 should be included along with the base option to allow the BAA to make the appropriate decision.

Question – Is the AED training just for AED use or is CPR certification training also required?

Answer – Training is for the full certification of employees to use the AED units in a CPR situation. CPR training must be included along with the AED training.
