The Birmingham Airport Authority (“Authority”) is seeking a highly qualified firm or team of firms (“Respondent”), to provide Professional Engineering Consulting Services associated with the preparation of an Environmental Assessment for the relocation of Taxiway “A” at the Birmingham International Airport, Birmingham, Alabama. The Authority is interested in a full range of services to facilitate a comprehensive assessment of the environment and the resulting impact on the environment should work be accomplished for the relocating of Taxiway “A”, and all affected facilities adjacent to and near the taxiway.
