Airport to Celebrate the Completion of a \$12.4 Million Dollar Airport Safety Project

BHM Hosting a Ribbon-Cutting and Unveiling at New ARFF Station

Birmingham, Al (November 28, 2022) - The Airport is preparing to cut the ribbon on a new Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting (ARFF) facility. The new ARFF station will be home base to the men and women who work around the clock to protect the airport, travelers, tenants, and the surrounding community in the event of an emergency.

ARFF services are a requirement at commercial airports. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) funded the majority of the cost for the \$12.4 million dollar facility, with the airport paying about 22% of the total cost. This is an example of how BHM leverages Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funds to enhance safety on the airfield. The airport team will also unveil new firefighting equipment that will be housed at the new station.

The media is invited to join us for the Ribbon-Cutting, unveiling, and facility tour on Tuesday, November 29th. Those attending will need to be inside the terminal *no later than 1pm* to catch the bus to the event site.
